VERDICT FORM A

We, the jury, find for Anthony Williams and against BNSF.

We further find the following:

First: Without taking into consideration the reduction of damages due to the negligence of Anthony Williams, if any, we find that the total amount of damages suffered by Anthony Williams as a result of the occurrence in question is \$ 2,676,960, itemized as follows:

Loss of a normal life experienced and reasonably certain to be experienced in the future:  
\$ 0

The value of lost earnings capacity and the present cash value of lost earnings capacity reasonably certain to be experienced in the future:  
\$ 1,396,821

The value of lost household/family housekeeping and household management services and the present cash value of lost household/family housekeeping and household management services reasonably certain to be experienced in the future:  
\$ 328,500

The pain and suffering experienced and reasonably certain to be experienced in the future as a result of the injuries:  
\$ 951,639

PLAINTIFF'S TOTAL DAMAGES: \$ 2,676,960

Second: As to the contribution claims against third-party defendant, QTS, we find as follows:

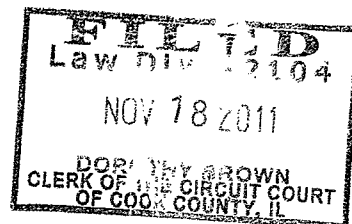

Third: Assuming that 100% represents the total combined negligence of all persons or entities whose negligence caused Anthony Williams' injury, including BNSF, QTS, and Anthony Williams, we find the percentage of such negligence attributable to each as follows:

- (a) BNSF 37.5 %
- (b) QTS 12.5 %
- (c) Anthony Williams 50 %
- TOTAL: 100 %

*(Instructions to Jury: If you find any defendant not liable to the plaintiff, or that any third-party defendant or non-party was not negligent in a way that proximately caused plaintiff's injury, or if you find that the plaintiff was not contributorily negligent, then you should enter a zero (0) as to that person or persons.)*

Fourth: After reducing the plaintiff's total damages of \$ 2,676,960 (from the paragraph First) by the percentage of negligence, if any, of Anthony Williams 50% (from line (c) in paragraph Third), we award Anthony Williams recoverable damages in the amount of \$ 1,338,480.
